2009 AUSTRALIAN MOTORKHANA CHAMPIONSHIP SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

Introduction

1. The Event

The event, the 2009 Renault Australian Motorkhana Championship, will be a National Championship Motorkhana, hereinafter referred to as "the AMC", held under CAMS Permit No: 209/0410/01

2. Date and Location

The AMC will be held on the 3rd and 4th October 2009.

The AMC will be held at Nirimba TAFE, Eastern Road, Quakers Hill NSW on a tarmac surface. Please refer to the attached maps for directions on how to get to the venue.

3. Authority

The AMC will be conducted under:

- The International Sporting Code of the FIA;
- The National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd. (CAMS);
- The National Motorkhana Code;
- The Group 4H – Motorkhana Cars regulations;
- These Supplementary Regulations;
- Any Further Regulations issued by the Organisers; and
- Any Directions issued to competitors by the Organisers.

This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au.

The Organisers reserve the right to postpone, abandon, or cancel the AMC in accordance with the provisions of NCR 59.

4. Promoters

All officials shall be deemed to be Judges of Fact in accordance with Article 18.2 and 18.3 of the National Motorkhana Code and NCR 181. The names of the Judges of Fact shall be displayed prior to the start of competition.

Entries

9. Entries

Entries will open on publication of these regulations and close at 8:00pm on Wednesday, 23rd September 2009. The AMC is open to all CAMS Level Two Non-Speed (or higher) Licence holders who hold a valid CAMS affiliated car club membership licence.

Up to 4 persons may be entered to drive the same vehicle, but multiple entries must be indicated on the entry form.

Entries will only be accepted on the official Entry Form (as attached to these Supplementary Regulations) which must be completed in all details and which must be accompanied by full remittance of all appropriate fees.

Competitors are requested to enter early to assist the Organisers with tasks such as printing of the program and publicity material. Competitors are also asked to provide information where indicated on the 'Publicity Form', to be used in event publicity and on the day of the event. By filling this form out and signing the document you authorise that this information can be used with the media and publicity for the event.

10. Limit of entries

Entries shall be limited to 80. Preference will be given in order of receipt of entry. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with NCR 83 and NCR 85.

11. Entry Fee

The entry fees are:

\$70.00 per adult driver;

\$35.00 for Junior drivers (less than 18 years of age on 4th October 2009. Proof of age will be required).

12. Competition Numbers

13. Insurance

Personal Accident and Public Risk Insurance as outlined in Appendix I of the 2009 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport is provided.

Classes

14. Vehicle Classes

The vehicle classes (based on manufacturers' specifications for production cars) shall be:

Class A	2WD Production Cars wheelbase up to 2150mm
Class B	2WD Production Cars wheelbase 2151mm to 2390mm
Class C	2WD Production Cars wheelbase 2391mm to 2574mm
Class D	2WD Production Cars wheelbase 2575mm and over
Class E	Four Wheel Drive Production Cars, which must be driven in four-wheel drive mode throughout the event.
Class F	Front Wheel Drive Specials
Class G	Rear Wheel Drive Specials

15. Additional Driver Categories

L	Ladies - Fastest Outright
LP	Ladies Production - Fastest in a Production Car
J	Junior - Fastest Outright
JP	Junior Production - Fastest in a Production Car

To qualify for categories J and/or JP, the driver must be less than 18 years but more than 12 years of age on the day of the AMC as specified in Regulation 4.5 of the National Motorkhana Code. The competitor must supply proof of age.

16. Awards

These awards will be presented at the Presentation Function held on the evening of the AMC. Other awards may be presented at the discretion of the Organisers. Trophies will be awarded as follows:

Award	Eligible Places
Outright Position	1 st through 6 th .
Vehicle Classes A, B, C, D, E, F, G	1 st , 2 nd , 3 rd (subject to sufficient entries).
Driver categories L, LP, J, JP	1 st , 2 nd , 3 rd (subject to sufficient entries).

Class and Category Awards are subject to competitor numbers in each class or category as follows:

- Over 6 competitors – 1st, 2nd and 3rd places
- 4 to 6 competitors – 1st and 2nd places
- up to 3 competitors – 1st place only.

17. Team Award

State-based teams may compete for a team award.

Each team, to be nominated to the Event Secretary by 10:00am on Sunday 4th October 2009, shall consist of three drivers competing in at least two vehicles.

Final aggregate time for each team member will be adjusted by a handicap factor (as listed). The team with the overall lowest aggregate handicap time will be determined the winner. All penalties are calculated at a factor of 1.00, not at the handicap factor.

The Handicap factor to be applied to each team member is based on vehicle classes as follows (calculated using the average of last 5 years results):

Class A	0.87
Class B	0.82
Class C	0.81
Class D	0.72
Class E	0.72
Class F	1.00
Class G	0.97

Documentation

18. Required Documents

Each competitor must possess a current CAMS Club Membership Card and at least a current CAMS Level Two Non-Speed (2NS) Licence, both of which must be presented. Documentation must be completed before presenting vehicle for scrutiny.

Junior competitors must have adequate proof of age.

Vehicles

19. Eligibility

All vehicles must comply with the requirements of the National Motorkhana Code and with Group 4H of Section 13 of the 2009 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. Specials are defined in Article 3 of Group 4H. Please note the new provisions of Section 2 – Production Cars under Group 4H.

The Clerk of the Course shall determine the appropriate class wherein each competitor shall be classified if there is any dispute as to entry class.

20. Scrutiny

Scrutiny will be held at the competition venue between 11:00am and 4:00pm on Saturday 3rd October 2009. No vehicle may be used to practice or compete without having first passed scrutiny and completed documentation.

Before being allowed to compete, competitors must present their vehicles with CAMS log books (if issued) and licences for examination, unless prior approval has been obtained from the Organisers for alternative scrutiny arrangements, which will only be granted in exceptional circumstances.

Each vehicle may be required to again pass scrutiny on the day of the event before being allowed to compete. (Please enter the scrutiny area in an orderly manner. Only competing vehicles are allowed in the scrutiny area).

As per the NCRs particular attention will be given to:

- Battery security.
- Safe condition of suspension and brakes.
- Roll over protection structures (if fitted).
- Safety harness / seat belts.
- Tyres.
- All vehicles must be effectively muffled, as required by Group 4H regulation 1.7.

Attention will be paid to the cleanliness and tidiness of vehicles.

Vehicles that have a mechanical failure at any time after the vehicle has been initially scrutinised may be required to present the vehicle for re-scrutineering.

21. Apparel

Whilst practicing or competing, all drivers must wear a seat belt complying with Schedule I &/or Group 4H of the 2009 CAMS manual, and amendments thereto.

Drivers of vehicles, which are registered with CAMS as Historic Cars, are subject to a Certificate of Description and not required under their Group Regulations to be fitted with a seat belt are currently exempt from the seat belt requirement above.

During practice and competition, drivers of "specials" (as defined by Group 4H) are required to wear a helmet complying with a standard listed in Schedule D, Article 1 of the 2009 CAMS manual. It is recommended that drivers of "open vehicles" wear helmets complying with these requirements also.

Drivers of "specials" and vehicles not fitted with a windscreen must wear proper eye protection (not sunglasses) complying with Schedule D during practice and competition.

22. Refuelling of Vehicles

All refuelling of competition vehicles will be completed in the designated area with at least two people present (one to refuel and one to man fire extinguishers). All people refuelling must be wearing neck to ankle clothing of a flame resistant material and substantial footwear.

Any vehicle being refuelled must have the engine turned off. The vehicle must not have any occupants during the refuelling procedure.

Competitors are reminded that fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual.

Event Structure

23. Practice

Controlled practice will be permitted on Saturday 3rd October 2009 for those competitors whose vehicles have passed scrutiny and completed documentation. No practice is scheduled for the Sunday of the AMC.

24. Tests

A minimum of four and a maximum of twelve tests will be conducted, chosen by the Organisers from the following list of CAMS approved Motorkhana tests (see NCR 4.)

Manoeuvring	Pentagon	Reverse Garage	Gables	Top Hat	Hopkirk
Triple Loop	Bowler	Paddy	Double Bone	Star	Crossover

Only one attempt will be permitted at each test, with the exception of a rerun having been granted by the Clerk of Course, as per NCR 16.

Test diagrams printed in the 2009 Australian Motorkhana Championship Program are taken from Edition 5 of the CAMS Motorkhana Tests. A copy of the program will be available from the Organisers upon request.

25. Event Layout

The layout of each test as laid down in the schedule of motorkhana tests shall be strictly adhered to, subject to a tolerance of +/- 200mm in each dimension, as specified in Regulation 12.3 of the National Motorkhana Code.

26. Timing

Electronic timing will be used on each test, backed up by up to two hand-held stopwatches. Timing will be to .01 of a second and will be recorded in writing.

Timing will start when the leading point of the vehicle crosses the designated start line, and will stop when the leading point of the vehicle crosses the designated finish line. The designated start and finish line will be the same line across the start and finish garage and will not be more than one metre behind the front of the garages.

Large display clocks only show indicative times. Official times may be different.

27. Starting Order

The starting order on each test will be determined by a rotational system based on classes. Details will be notified in Further Regulations and repeated at the Drivers' Briefing.

28. Shoot-out

The Clerk of the Course reserves the right to run a shoot-out at the end of the competitive day if time permits, using his choice of test taken from the CAMS Motorkhana Tests Booklet.

The method of determining the drivers eligible for the shootout and the handicap or driver performance index (DPI) used to determine the winner of the shootout shall be announced at the drivers briefing.

General

29. Protests

Any protests must be lodged in accordance with the provisions of part XII of the NCR.

30. Alcohol and Drugs

During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Standard Operating Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) or other drugs at any time during the event(s).

Other Prohibited Substances

The CAMS Anti Doping Policy, as appears in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and as amended from time to time, is recognised as an integral component of the NCR and is duly authorised as such. In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the CAMS Anti Doping Policy conflict, the CAMS Anti Doping Policy will take precedence.

31. Catering at the venue

Food and drinks will be available on Saturday and Sunday and conveniences will be open at the venue.

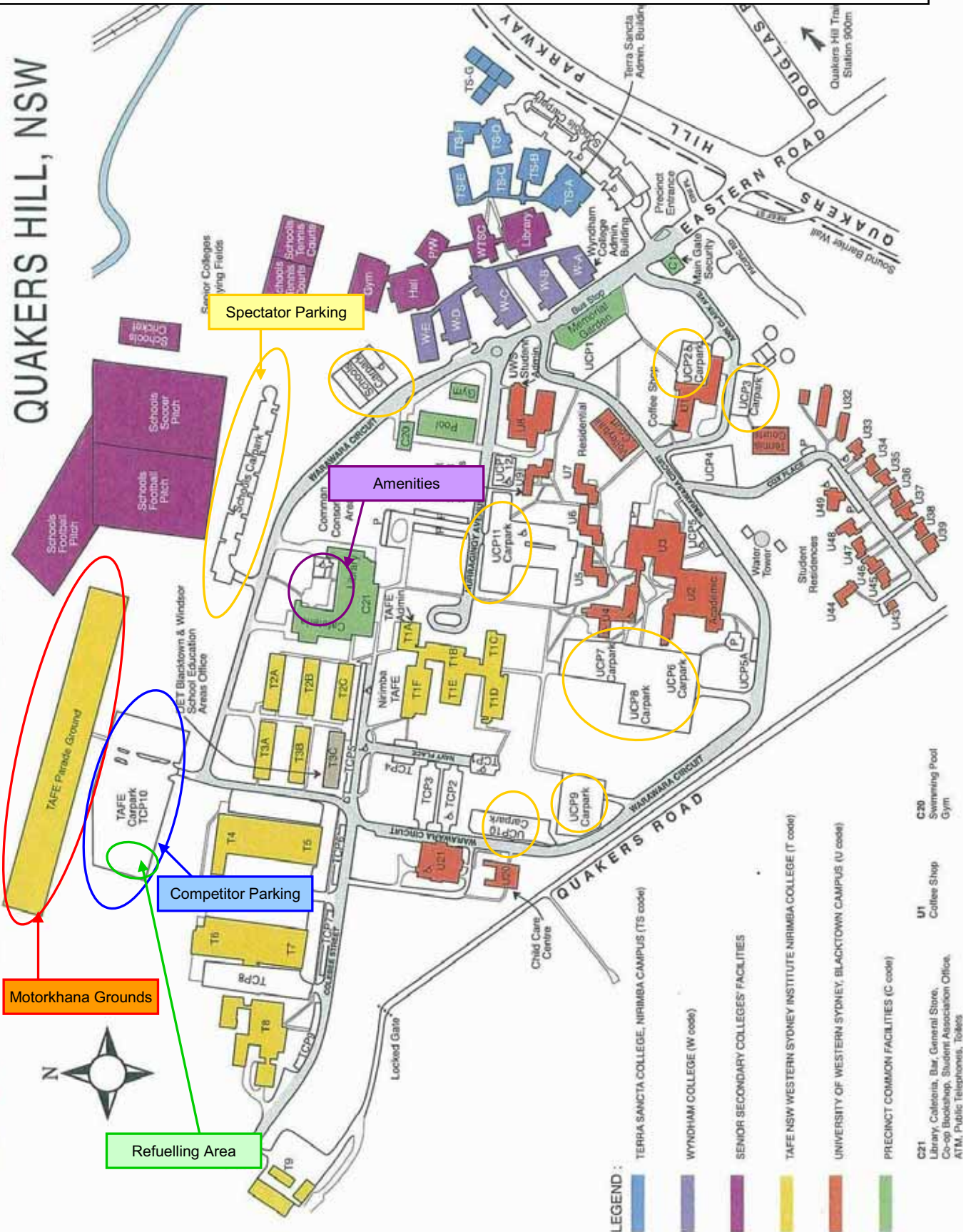
Map of Competition Venue

Take the exit toward Quakers Hill Pkwy, travel 0.5km on off-ramp

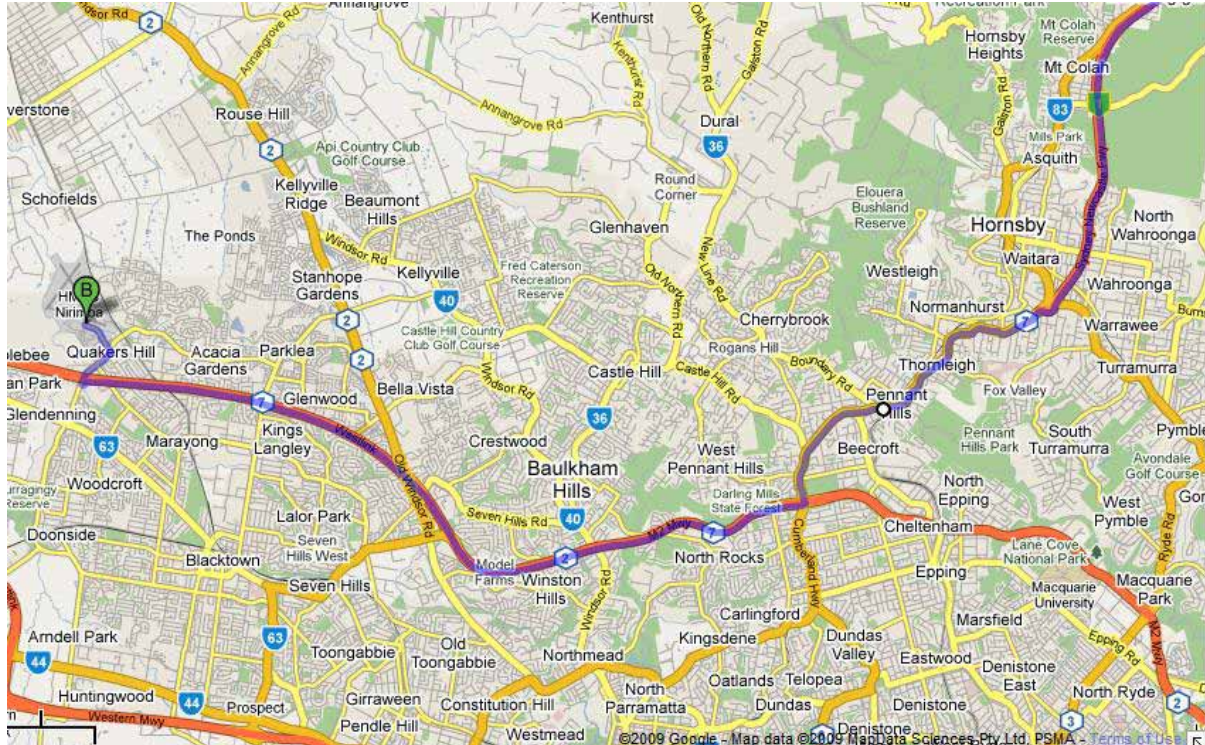
Turn right at Quakers Hill Pkwy, travel 1.0km

Follow Eastern Rd, veering right through roundabout after 100m

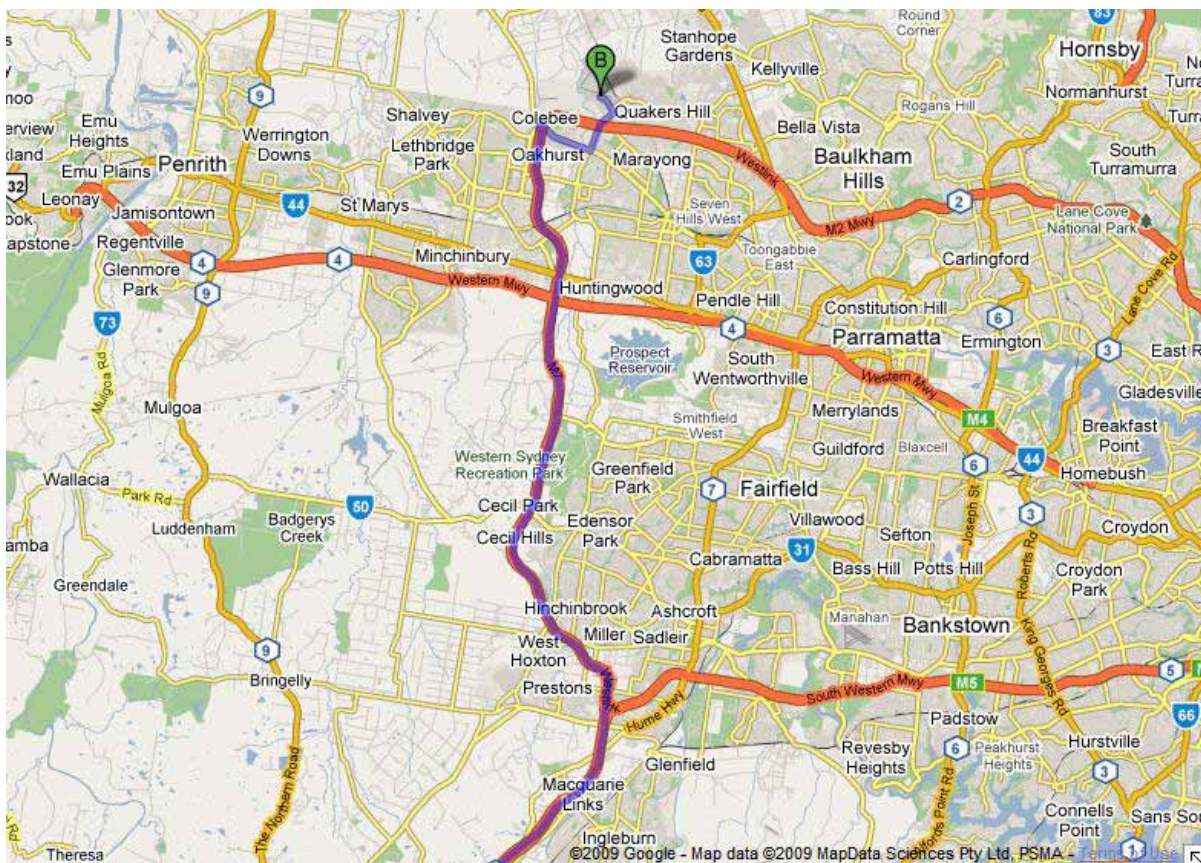

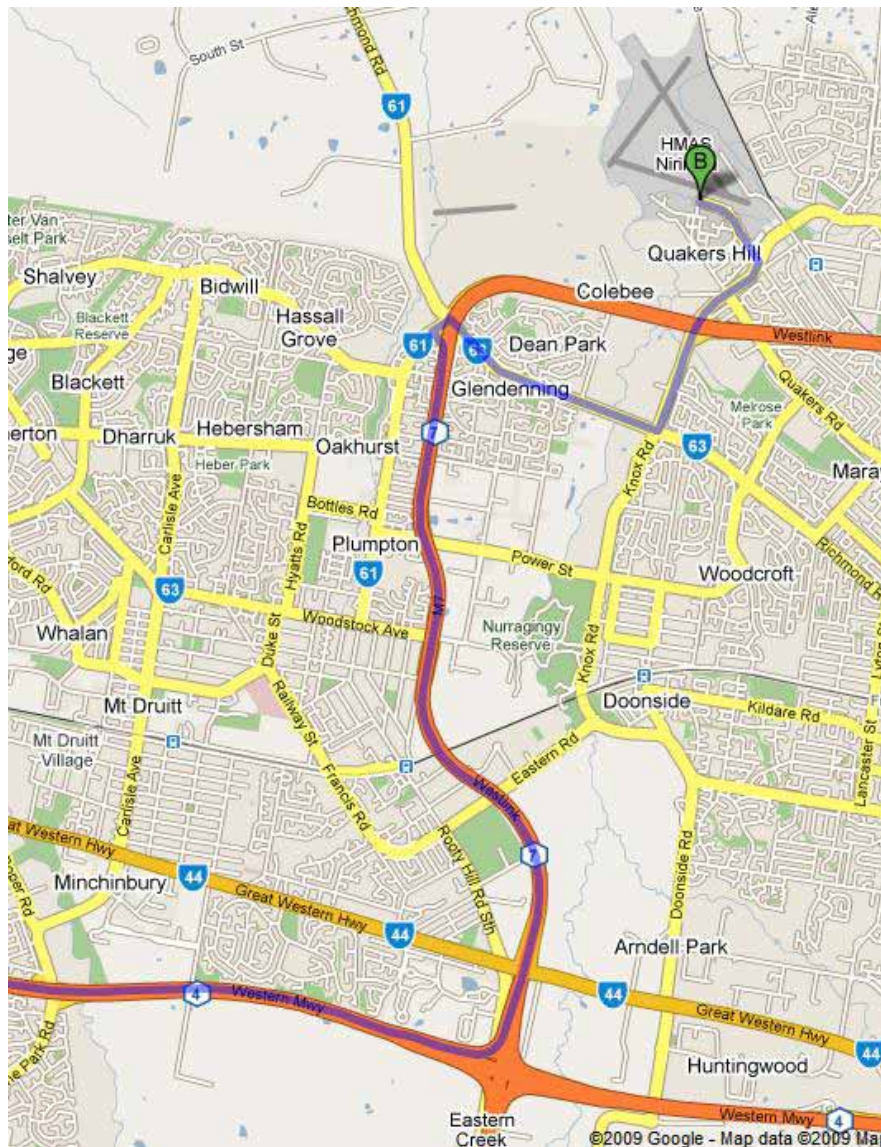
From South of Sydney:

- Turn right at Richmond Rd, travel 2.3km

- Turn right into Competitor Carpark



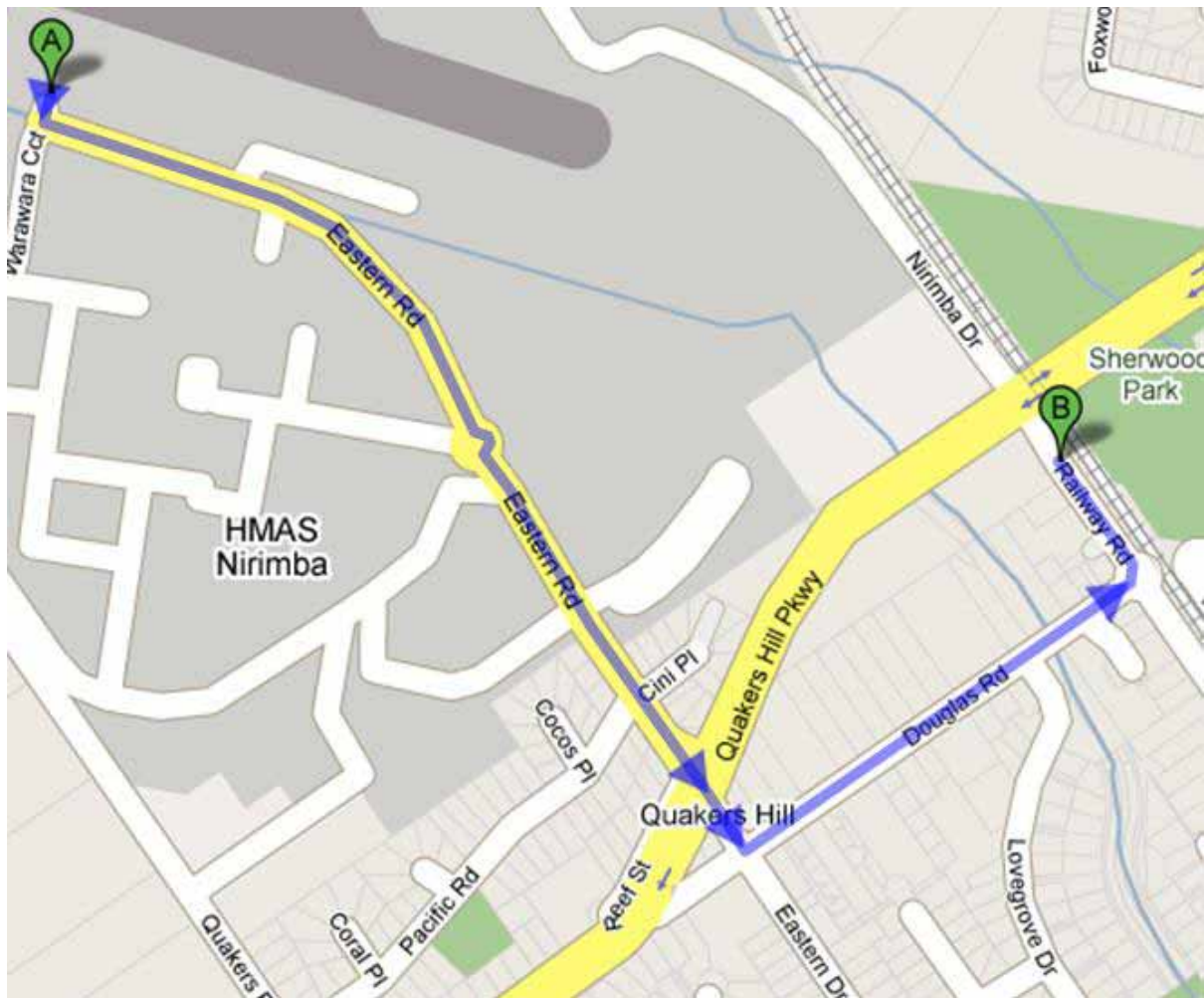
From West of Sydney:

- Turn right at North Rooty Hill Rd, travel 200m
- Turn right at Richmond Rd, travel 2.3km
- Turn left at lights, onto Quakers Hill Pkwy, travel 2.0km
- Turn left at Eastern Rd, proceed 200m into Nirimba TAFE
- Follow Eastern Rd, veering right through roundabout after 100m
- Follow Eastern Rd, for 800m
- Turn right into Competitor Carpark

 At the roundabout, go straight on, onto Knox Rd, travel for 3.0km, crossing 2 roundabouts
 At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Eastern Rd, travel for 700m
 At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit onto Doonside Rd, travel for 2.7km going through 1 roundabout
