This year the generosity is extended to make it free entry for regular competitors; but please don't forget to bring your valid CAMS licence and club membership card with you.

As if that's not enough good news, it's also being held at the RAC Driver Training Centre which is more central and easier to get to than the Neerabup venue.

There will also be a gang of "experienced" drivers on hand to give the newcomers a bit of advice during their first few runs.

Entry is on the day and to keep administration time to a minimum we would ask that you are there for sign on between 9 and 9:45am. We will allow some late entries but there may be admin delays before you can get out on the courses.

Supp Regs are currently being approved by CAMS and they will be posted on the Motorkhana WA website very shortly. Keep an eye out for them and to speed up administration could you bring along a filled out entry form with you on the 19th.
