



## SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS - BEGINNERS MOTORKHANA

### EVENT TYPE, STATUS AND DATE

The event will be a multi-club non-competitive come and try Motorkhana and entry is open to members of CAMS affiliated car clubs in WA and newcomers to the sport. Tests from the Motorkhana Tests booklet will be set up and drivers can practice various skills and manoeuvres. The event will be conducted on Sunday, February 19<sup>th</sup> 2012. The event will be run under the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS) permit number: 612/1902/01

### AUTHORITY

The event will be held under the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A.; the National Competition Rules of CAMS, the National Motorkhana Code, the Guidelines for Passengers in Vehicles, the CAMS Come and Try Policy, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations issued by the organisers.

This event will be conducted under and in accordance with the CAMS Risk Management and Occupational Health and Safety Policies. These policies and the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport can be found at [www.cams.com.au](http://www.cams.com.au)

### VENUE

The event will be conducted at the RAC Driver Training Centre, Grogan Road, Perth Intl. Airport. The event will be run on a bitumen surface.

**ENTRY** Entries will be only be accepted on the day up to a maximum of 100.

Entry Fee \$0 (free event)

The organiser reserves the right to refuse entry in accordance with NCR 83. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.

**JUNIORS** Drivers older than 12 and younger than 18 are classified as juniors; they must have basic car control skills. An experienced adult observer must accompany the junior driver whilst they are driving. This observer will be required until it is determined the junior driver has the ability to safely control their vehicle.

**LICENCES** Drivers will be required to hold a minimum of a Level 1 CAMS licence or superior for the event. Level 1 licenses will be supplied by the Mini Car Club to newcomers to the sport. This single event licence is only valid for one event per year. Any instructor (to be authorised by the Clerk of the Course) who will be a passenger or driver will be required to hold an L2NS or superior licence and a valid CAMS affiliated car club membership card. Passengers must sign the relevant disclaimer and all passenger aspects of the event shall be run in accordance with the Guidelines for Passengers in Vehicles.

### DRIVER REQUIREMENTS

All drivers whilst driving must wear a minimum of a properly adjusted lap-type seat belt (drivers of cars registered with CAMS as historic cars are exempted from this requirement.). All apparel shall be in accordance with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual.

Helmets are mandatory for drivers of Specials. They are highly

recommended for drivers of open top cars.

Drivers of vehicles to which a windscreen is not fitted shall wear adequate eye protection whilst competing.

Adequate footwear shall be worn whilst competing. Bare feet, thongs or sandals are not permitted.

**VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS** The maximum allowable noise level emitted from vehicles competing in WA Motorkhana events for 2012 will be 95db. This maximum must not be exceeded anywhere throughout the "rev range" when competing. Fuel shall be in accordance with Schedule G. Participants will need to present their current vehicle logbook (if issued) at scrutiny.

**ABANDONMENT** The organisers reserve the right to abandon or alter the event, in accordance with NCR 59 and if there are less than 20 entries.

**CLASSES** All cars must comply with Schedule A and Group 4H Regulations (refer CAMS Manual).

Class A	Production vehicles wheelbase 1800 mm - 2150 mm
Class B	Production vehicles wheelbase 2151 mm - 2390 mm
Class C	Production vehicles wheelbase 2391 mm - 2650 mm
Class D	Production vehicles wheelbase over 2650 mm
Class E	4WD production vehicles
Class F	FWD specials
Class G	RWD specials

Specials are defined as any vehicle which has been significantly lightened, or any non-production vehicle, or any vehicle fitted with an additional brake pedal which operates primarily on the rear wheels which is not standard on that vehicle, or any vehicle fitted with racing or "slick tyres". Production vehicles fitted with hydraulic hand brakes which operate both wheels equally, do not classify as specials.

**AMENITIES** Soft drinks, water and snacks available at the venue. Toilet facilities are also available.

**INSURANCE** Insurance cover is provided by CAMS in accordance with Appendix I of the current CAMS Manual.

**PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES** During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Standard Operating Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) or other drugs at any time during the event(s).

**RESULTS** There will be no results, timing, or awards for this event as it will be non-competitive.
