Supplementary Regulations

EVENT TYPE & STATUS The Motorkhana, hereafter referred to as "the event" will be Round 1 of the WA State Motorkhana Championship for 2009. The event will be run under the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS) permit number: 610/2103/04

DATE & VENUE The event will be conducted on March 21, 2010 at the Tiger Kart Club, Wattle Ave, Neerabup. Competition will be on a bitumen surface..

AUTHORITY The event will be held under the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A, the National Competition Rules of CAMS (NCRs), the National Motorkhana Code, the Passenger in Vehicle Guidelines, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations or directions issued by the organiser. The event will also be conducted under and in accordance with the CAMS Risk Management and Occupational Health and Safety Policies. ABANDONMENT The organiser reserves the right to abandon or alter the event, in accordance with the NCR 59 and if there are less than 20 entries.

ENTRIES Completed entry forms, together with correct payment must be forwarded to the Event Secretary by 7.00 pm on Thursday, April 30. Late entries will definitely NOT be accepted. There is a limit of four (4) drivers per vehicle and the entry field will be limited to 150 competitors, accepted in order of receipt.

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP ENTRIES Where clubs have incorporated the event as part of their 'Club Championship' then entries will be accepted from members of those clubs who wish to participate on a 'Club Only' basis at the reduced entry fee.

This reduced entry fee does not entitle the entrant to State Championship points or any trophies as listed, or to be a member of a team.

Entries may be refused in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual.

TEAM ENTRIES Team entries will be accepted on the day of the event up until 9.30 am. A team must comprise of three (3) drivers, submitted on a club basis and consist of at least two (2) vehicles. Multiple team entries by the same driver are not permissible. The team name and members should preferably remain the same for all rounds of the Championship as points are allocated on the basis of the team name. However it may be permissible to substitute up to three drivers over the Championship series.

LICENCES Competitors will be required to produce a current Level 2NSJ or higher grade CAMS licence together with a current (CAMS affiliated) club membership card at registration/scrutiny. Level 1 (come and try) licences may be available on the day, from the organiser.

Competitors holding a Level 1 license will not be included in the results, nor will any times from their runs on the tests be published; however, from all other aspects the competitor will be competing on the same basis as State Championship competitors.

COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS All drivers whilst competing must wear a minimum of a properly adjusted lap-type seat belt (drivers of cars registered with CAMS as historic cars are exempted from this requirement).

Helmets to AS 1698 are mandatory for drivers of Specials. They are highly recommended for drivers of open top cars.

Drivers of vehicles to which a windscreen is not fitted shall wear adequate eye protection whilst competing.

Adequate footwear shall be worn whilst competing. Bare feet, thongs or sandals are not permitted. The minimum age for drivers is twelve. All drivers must be able to demonstrate an ability to safely control their vehicle.

All drivers must attend the drivers' briefing which will be at the venue prior to competition commencing.

VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS All cars must comply with Schedule A and Group 4H Regulations (refer CAMS Manual). All vehicles must be mechanically safe, and must pass a scrutiny check which will be at the venue, before they are allowed to be driven in competition.

Exposed rotating engine parts and exhaust manifolds, including fans, belts, ancillaries and extractors, must have guards to prevent injury. This requirement is particularly applicable to cars in Class F and G.

The maximum allowable noise level emitted from vehicles competing in the event will be 95db. This maximum must not be exceeded anywhere throughout the "rev range" when competing.

FUEL Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual.

CLASSES The following classes shall apply:

Class A Production vehicles, wheelbase 1800 mm - 2150 mm

Class B Production vehicles, wheelbase 2151 mm - 2390 mm

Class C Production vehicles, wheelbase 2391 mm - 2574 mm

Class D Production vehicles, wheelbase over 2575 mm

Class E 4WD production vehicles

Class F FWD specials

Class G RWD specials

Note: In the event of there being less than three entries in any one class, the class may be merged with another at the discretion of the Director.

CLASS F & G Specials are defined as any vehicle which has been significantly lightened, or any non-production vehicle, or any vehicle fitted with an additional brake pedal which operates primarily on the rear wheels which is not standard on that vehicle, or any vehicle fitted with racing or "slick

tyres". Production vehicles fitted with hydraulic hand brakes, which operate both wheels equally, do not classify as specials.

NUMBERS A ballot will be held to determine the starting order in each class. Numbers will be issued at scrutiny.

RUNNING ORDER Competitors are required to run in numerical order unless otherwise permitted by the Director. Details of the starting order and order of tests will be tests will be distributed at registration.

TIMING Automatic timing will be used for the event with 2 manual stopwatch back-ups. All times will be recorded. Should the automatic timing fail during a test, at the discretion of the Director, the test may be run on manual timing. Timing will be recorded to 100th of a second.

JUDGES OF FACT & TIMING OFFICIALS Judges of Fact and Timing officials will be appointed to observe the correct procedure.

TESTS It is proposed to use up to 10 of tests from the Australian Motorkhana Test Booklet. The tests will be selected from the following:

Plumb Crazy; Hopkirk; Forward & Reverse Slalom; Double hat; Spiro Slalom; Lazy Eight; Gate Slalom; Multiple Loop; Mirror Serpentine; Mirror Cloverleaf; Butterfly; Reverse Lazy Eight; Crazy Square; Mirror Straight Slalom; Hopscotch; Manoeuvring; Hopscotch..

PROTESTS Any protest shall be in accordance with NCR Part XII.

STATE CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS Placings in the State Championship shall be determined by a system of point scores per round as follows: 1st receives 15 points, decreasing to 1 point for 15th outright. Only the competitor's best four rounds will count towards the State Championship.

HANDICAP CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS Placings in the Handicap Championship will be determined by multiplying each competitor's aggregate time by the appropriate handicap factor for their class (set out below). Placings will then be awarded points as follows, 1st - 15 points, decreasing to 1 point for 15th place. Only the competitor's best four rounds count towards the State Handicap Championship.

TROPHIES Trophies will be awarded at a "Series Presentation" which will be held some time after the final Round of the Championship. Trophies may include the following:

1st to 6th Outright; 1st to 3rd in each class; 1st Lady Driver and 1st Lady in a production car. 1st Junior FWD and 1st Junior RWD. 1st Novice (Driver must have entered their first State Championship event in the current series)

Handicap Championship trophies will be awarded for 1st to 3rd over the series.

Note: Where a competitor qualifies for more than one trophy, one trophy listing achievements will be awarded.

INSURANCE Insurance cover is provided by CAMS in accordance with Appendix I of the current CAMS Manual.

PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Standard Operating Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) or other drugs at any time during the event(s).
